

Hollyhock Fabric Requirements

2 ½" wide wof strips:	Dark Green/Teal	Berry/Merlot	Lights - any color
Berry Bliss Bali Pop™ contains:	12	7	20
Hollyhocks Requires:	7	15	17
Cut an additional:		8 strips	

You also need to add these fabrics to complete the quilt top:

Lavender:
5 strips 2½" wide wof

Watercolor Blue:
1 square 8" &
8 strips 3½" wide wof

Dark Teal:
4 strips 2" wide wof

If you wish to create the quilt HollyHocks *exactly* as you see it in the book "Sizzle 'n Pop", cut the colors into rectangles as follows:

Block A:

From Berry/Merlot 2 ½" wide wof strips:
Cut (12) 4 ½" rectangles
Cut (25) 6 ½" rectangles
Cut (7) 8 ½" rectangles

Dark Green 2 ½" wide wof strips:

Cut (2) 4 ½" rectangles
Cut (5) 6 ½" rectangles
Cut (8) 8 ½" rectangles

From any color light 2 ½" wide wof strips:

Cut (15) 8 ½" rectangles
Cut (15) 10 ½" rectangles

Block B:

From Berry/Merlot 2 ½" wide wof strips:
Cut (4) 8 ½" rectangles
Cut (8) 10 ½" rectangles

Dark Teal/Green 2 ½" wide wof strips:

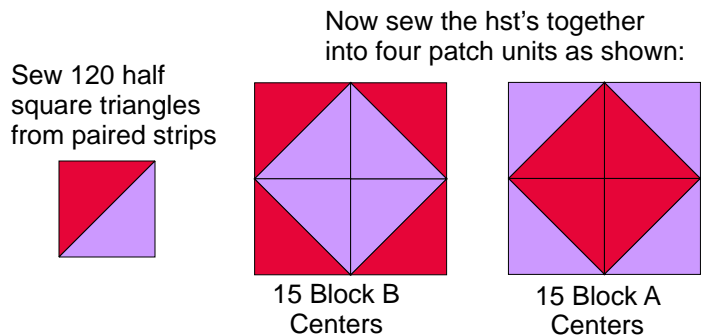
Cut (11) 8 ½" rectangles
Cut (7) 10 ½" rectangles

From any color light 2 ½" wide wof strips:

Cut (15) 4 ½" rectangles
Cut (30) 6 ½" rectangles
Cut (15) 8 ½" rectangles

For Centers of blocks A and B:

Use 4 ½ strips of Merlot/Berry with 4 ½ strips of Lavender to create centers of blocks. 15 units will have lavender in the center (used in Block B) and 15 of the units will have berry/merlot in the center (used in Block A).



To create the setting triangles for the quilt:

Cut 8 strips 3 ½" wide, wof from blue watercolor fabric (just as instructed in the book).

Cut 4 strips 2" wide, wof from dark teal fabric.

Continue to follow the instructions on page 3 for sewing bands together and cutting setting triangles and corner triangles for pieced top and to piece the top together. Refer to the photograph if you need help figuring out where the colors in each block should be placed.

You will have strips left over from your Berry Bliss Bali Pop™ (5 dark strips and 3 light strips as well as 1 gold strip). Enjoy using these to create a smaller project or in a future strip pieced quilt.
